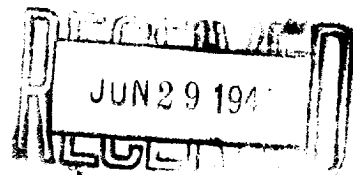

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

1. On May 26, 1948, the hole was mudded with 22 sacks Aguagel, 48 Zeogel and 22 clay.
2. Ran 52 joints of 7" -- 26#, R-3, J-55, new Pittsburg T&C snls casing with Texas Pattern shoe and landed at 2126' in 8-3/4" hole.
3. On June 18, 1948, after drilling to 2138' with cable tools, the hole was bailed dry and no fluid entered on a 1-hour test.
