## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

11-3/4" cemented at 196'; 7" landed at 2126'. Total depth 2838'.

We propose:

1. Plug bottom 2838-2788' with cement.
2. Plug 2305-2255' with cement.
3. Pull the 7" casing.
4. Plug 216-176' with cement, leaving the 11-3/4" in place.
5. Place a 10' surface plug and erect marker.
6. The unplugged spaces will be left full of heavy mud.
