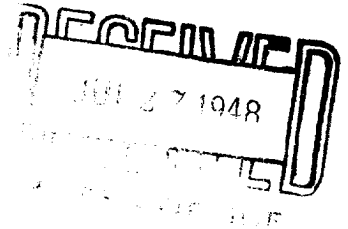

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

1. Six sacks of cement were dumped to plug 2838-2788'.
2. Six sacks of cement were dumped to plug 2305-2255'.
3. All of the 7" casing was pulled from 2126'.
4. Twenty sacks of cement were dumped to plug 216-176'.
5. Four sacks of cement were dumped in the surface of the 11-3/4", none of which was pulled, and a marker was erected.
6. All unplugged spaces were left full of heavy mud.
