Drill Cement from Casing to 3750'. Apply 500 p. s. i. to Casing. Bail Casing dry and perforate @ 3545' w/ 4-9/16" gun perforations to test shut off at that point.

If above test proves shut off is satisfactory, Casing will then be perforated between 3550'- 3750' to make production test.
