DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 8260 feet. Casing cemented as follows: 13-3/8" @ 149' with 175 sacks; 8-5/8" @ 1900' with 350 sacks.

Plugged well as follows:

1. 8230 - 8150' with 25 sacks cement;  
6900 - 6825' with 30 sacks cement;  
1950 - 1870' with 30 sacks cement.

2. Out 8-5/8" casing @ 1034 feet and pulled same.

3. Placed 15 sacks cement in hole at surface and set regulation marker.

Hole was loaded with 6 cc. water loss drilling mud before plugging operations were commenced.

Abandonment complete December 1, 1954.
