Spot cement plugs as follows:

- 35 cu. plug in 7-7/8" open hole from 8246-8360 feet
- 25 cu. plug from 1870-1950 feet
- 20 cu. plug in 8-5/8" casing from 0-30 feet

Cement 4" marker pipe in top of 8-5/8" surface casing.
