DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

8" Casing was shot off at 2300-ft leaving in hole 187-ft and filled from total depth of 5090-ft to 2463-ft; 10" Casing was then pulled, recovering all, or 2463-ft; hole filled with heavy mud to 1400-ft and 21-sacks cement, which filled to 1375-ft; heavy mud to 1354-ft; used Collar Buster on 12 1/2" Casing at 1163-ft and pulled, leaving 171-ft 4-inches in hole; filled with heavy mud to 835-ft, and 14-sacks cement filled it to 830-ft. Filled with heavy mud to 580-ft and shot off 15 1/2" Casing at 511-ft, leaving in hole 68-ft. Filled with mud to 340-ft and cemented with 14-sacks. Pulled all 20" Casing and filled to surface, cemented marker on top consisting of Joint of 15 1/2" Casing.
