It is proposed to place cement inside of 9 5/8 casing which was cemented to the surface from 15' below ground level to surface, 10.2 mud from 3150' up to 15' then cement from 3230' up to 3150', then 10.2 mud from 8590' up to 3230', then cement from 8780' up to 8590', the 10.2 mud from 8911' TD up to 8780'. A four foot pipe marker to be left cemented at location. Work to be done by Halliburton.
