Cement plugs placed at the following intervals: 7150' to 7250', 3150' to 3250', 2850' to 2950', 1,000' to 1100', 300' to 400', surface to 5'. Heavy and laden fluid between all cement plugs. 4-1/2" casing, 5' log, erected over well site. Plugging was done by E. A. County Gas Co. (Tril Service Co.).

Recovered 3150' of 4-1/2" casing, 300' of 5" casing.
