DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Abandonment Work:

1. 44 sacks Atlas cement were dumped to plug 2515-2220'.
2. The 7" casing was shot with a light shot and pulled from 2195', the total amount.
3. 18 sacks cement were dumped to plug 215-175'.
4. 5 sacks cement were dumped at the surface and a 4 1/2" marker was erected.
5. The 11-3/4" cemented at 195' was left in place and all unplugged spaces were left full of heavy mud.
