DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

1. Halliburton pumped 125 sacks of El Toro cement through drill pipe at 2400' to fill to 2134', and 28 sacks at 1840' to fill to 1788'.
2. On July 14, 1947, 10 sacks were dumped as a surface plug in the 11-5/4" casing and a 4' marker extending 4' above the surface was erected.
