

Dear Sir:

Replying to your letter of recent date concerning the above Well, please be advised that all of the $8\frac{1}{4}$ inch Casing has been pulled from that well. At the time that the $8\frac{1}{4}$ inch Casing was pulled, there was about seventy feet left in the hole which was later drilled up when an attempt was made to deepen the hole. The ten inch hole was reamed to 3470 feet where the tools were lost.

We are now attempting to fish tools out of the hole and as soon as we are successful, we would like very much to plug this well and will notify you so that you can be there, or can have a representative there.
