My dear Roy:

Reference is made to your letter of February 24 regarding Form C-105 (Well Record) which Mr. Rip C. Underwood states that he did not receive from this office. Enclosed please find the well record in question.

However, the well history insofar as the records of this office reflect ~~are~~ very incomplete as to the well in question. There is on file only the intention to drill and the well record on Form C-105. As gathered from the well record, this well in question is a dry hole and must be abandoned. There should be on file Notice of Intention to Plug and also Report on Plugging the Well both approved by authorized agent of the Commission. This is important for the question may later come up as to the proper abandonment of the well, in question.
