There is on file only the intention to drill and the well record on Form C-105. As gathered from the well record, this well inquestion is a dry hole and must be abandoned. There should be on file Notice of Intention to Plug and also Report on Plugging the Well both approved by authorized agent of the Commission. This is important for the question may later come up as to the proper abandonment of the well, in question.
