We pulled pipe and filled the hole with mud to 2515'. Bridged at 2515' and cemented with 10 sacks cement. Filled hole with mud to bottom of 10", bridged and cemented at 1484' with 5 sacks cement. Filled with mud to surface and cemented with 5 sacks cement, placed 4" marker extending four feet above the ground, conforming with the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission.
