Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of Form SG 101, "Notice of Intention to Drill New Well" for your State Well No. 1 in SEC SW 1/4 of Sec. 2, T. 8S., R. 23 E., Chaves County.

You are advised that it will be necessary to submit and receive the approval of a bond in connection with this well assuring compliance with New Mexico laws, rules and regulations dealing with oil and gas. Enclosed is a form of bond that will meet with the approval of this office. It should be a surety company bond in the amount of \$2000.00 if you do not plan to go deeper than two thousand feet. The amount of the bond should be increased somewhat if a greater depth is anticipated. It is essential that an approved bond be filed in this office before Form G101 can be approved. We trust that you will attend to the bond at your earliest convenience.
