Gentlemen:

A field inspection of the subject well August 28, 1969, revealed that the same has been converted to salt water disposal. Said inspection further showed that disposal operations are already under way. However, the report of the conversion has not been filed as required.

Form C-103 must be filed with this office immediately giving details of the conversion as noted below:

1. Tubing, show size, weight, lining material and length.
2. Packer, show size, model and setting depth.
3. Show perforated interval used for water disposal.
4. Show type of inert fluid used to load the casing-tubing annulus and that the annulus is equipped with a pressure gauge.
5. Show the dates that the work was performed and the date of first injection.

Additionally, a monthly report of the volume of water injected and cumulative water injected is required. This report is to be filed on Form C-120A, 3 copies. A supply of this form is enclosed for your convenience.
