Chaves County School Tax

Reference is made to the inclosed statement of assessment value on well and pump, located on the Dale-Federal Lease, Chaves County, New Mexico.

It is noteworthy, that the Number 3 well is essentially a dry hole, and probably should have been plugged. It makes only $\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 barrels a day, and just about pays for the electricity to pump it. Th equipment on it is old and obsolete and its assessed value should not be anymore than that located on the Number 1 well, if it should be assessed as much.

I will appreciate your consideration. None of the wells in this area are worth anywhere near the cost to complete them, and should not be taxed as if they were good producing wells.
