1. That he is District Supt. of Cities Service Oil Company

2. That Cities Service Oil Co. is the operator of a well drilled on land be-

longing to Charles Essary, whose address is Route #1, Dexter,

said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and described as the Stone A No. 1, being located 2080 feet from the North line and 560 feet from the west line of Section 20, Township 12 S, Range 26 E, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.

3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of _____ feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows: 13 3/8" 48# set @ 450' w/500 sax reg., circulated 8 5/8" 24# set @ 2199.54' w/825 sax 50-50 pozmix + 4% gel + 10% salt, followed by 200 sax neat Incor, cement circulated.

4. That operator and landowner have made an agreement whereby operator (is) ~~XXXXXX~~ to back fill pits, level location, and clear it of all junk. The agreement further provides that operator is to plug said well back to a plugged-back total depth of 1073 feet and transfer well to landowner for his use as a water-well. Operator will leave casing in the well as follows: all casing left in well and cemented to surface.

5. That when operator has complied with the provisions of Paragraph 4 above it will so notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Commission Form C-103, together with a signed statement from the landowner that the provisions of Paragraph 4 above have been complied with to his satisfaction.
