As stated above actual drilling commenced on Thursday Oct 29 1948 at about 3:30 PM. Sand was caving so bad that we run 15 inch OD casing and let it follow the drilling untill we reached a depth of 206 feet, then we encountered a hard streak of clay and lime, it was impossible to carry this string farther so we then put in or ran 12 1/2 inch casing and allowed it to follow the drilling and we are still using this string and will continue too untill we get a hard shoulder to around six hundred feet, we then intend to cement this string and will notify
