Dear Mr. Sweeney:

Since February of this year this office has been attempting to cause the final plugging, clean up and disposition of the subject well. Enclosed you will find copies of our letters of February 18 and April 7, 1970, to this effect. On May 1 and July 21, 1970, you called advising that the clean up and final plugging would shortly be completed.

An inspection of the well site September 14, 1970, indicates that no work has as yet been done. The well is standing open, full of water, with bubbles of gas or air coming to the surface.

As this matter has been pending for over three years, this office now feels that final plugging must be accomplished without further delay. A determination of the source of the gas or air bubbles must be made and appropriate corrective measures taken. This office must be notified prior to the performance of any work at the well so that the same may be witnessed by a Commission representative.
