
Enclosed please find a new form C-103 on the subject well.

In reply to your final question, please be advised that a change was made in the cementing of the long string without approval inasmuch as the original cementing program contemplated running a DV tool. At casing time Dowell Company advised the DV tool was an unnecessary risk and they recommended running the 500 sacks of cement which would be sufficient to cover all the Devonian, Mississippian, Pennsylvanian, Abo and into the Glorietta formation up to 5000 feet. Since this is far more than is normally necessary for cementing a long string it was considered sufficient by our company. Through error your office was not notified. If you have objections to this method of cementing the long string please advise.

We shall endeavor to seek your advice forthwith in the future should a change in plans be contemplated.
