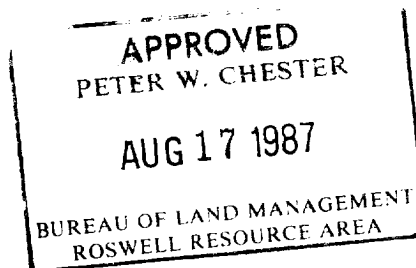
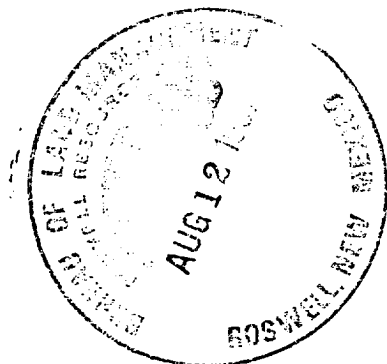
Previously approved 8/13/87 { The subject well produces 3 to 4 bbls. of formation water per day. It is currently being produced into a 210-bbl. tank on the wellsite location. Water that does not evaporate is periodically hauled to disposal sites by Jim's Water Service.

A fenced surface pit, measuring 20' x 20' x 4' deep is currently maintained for emergency use, draining sand and sediment from the separator (the well produces small amounts of formation sand), etc. *(no oil, a few gallons of salt water)*.

Approval is hereby requested for approval to sustain the surface pit.
