Drilled 17½" hole, with rat hole digger, to 30' and set 13 3/8" 48# H 40 casing at 30' and cemented with 4 yards of ready mix.

Drilled 11" hole, with rotary, to 1350' and set 8 5/8" 24# K55 casing at 1350' KB. Cemented with 650 sx HOWCO Litegate containing 5# Gilsonite/sx, 1# Flocele/sx and 2% CaCl plus 200 sx Incor w/2% CaCl, cement circulated, PD 1:30 p.m. 11-11-70. Nipped up BOP and tested BOP and casing to 1000#, held okay. To WOC 18 hours and drill ahead

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
