This well was spudded on 6/21/71 and 13-3/8" O.D. conductor casing was cemented at 26' (G.L.) with 3 cu.yds. ready mix to surface. On 6/22/71 Ford Drilling Company rig started drilling 11" hole, reaching a depth of 1,295', 40' into the San Andres, and cemented new 8-5/8" OD 24, 1-55 WT&C casing at total depth on 6/24/71 at 2:00 PM. with 250 sks HLM cement + 25 CaCl₂ + 50 Gel & 1/4" Floccle/sk and 250 sks Class 8 cement with 25 CaCl₂. Cement circulated to surface. Waited on cement 16 hrs. and tested casing with 1000 psi for 30 minutes at 8:00 AM 6/25/71 with no loss in test pressure.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
