Opened tool for 5 min., GTS in 4 min, 170% on 1/4" choke, shut it 60 min., opened tool for 90 min, 140%, 1/2" choke, max. 1475%, 9.3 MM. Recovered 60 ft. of distillate and 700' water. Drilled 7-7/8" hole to 6,294', ran DST #2 7/11/71, 6270-6294' (Montoya). I.F. 10 min. weak blow air, shut in 60 min., opened tool 60 min., weak blow air died in 60 min. Recovered 120' of drilling mud.
- 7/12/71 - Ran logs GR/A, Guard, Porosa
7/13/71 - Ran 4-1/2" 9.5% E-55 STAG casing to 6,041', cmt w/ 250 ex Class C Bent. Release rig. YBTS 5964'.
- RING DRAG completion unit. Spotted 100 gal acetic acid 5832-5796'. Ran GR-OLL + OBL, top of cmt @ 5,000', good bond throughout. Perf Cisco 1 hole/foot @ 5796-98, 5802-05', 5819-24, 5830-32 (16 holes). Set Baker Model R on 2-3/8" 4.7% E-55 BBL @ 5686'. Loaded annulus w/60 bbl inhibited brine water.
- 7-19-71 - Acidized w/1000 gal 15% HCL. Flowed well to clean up.
7-20-71 - Ran 4 pt. test - AOF 28.374 MMCF/D

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
