## Gentlemen:

On November 15, 1971 we requested and received a sixty day extension from December 1, 1971 for the second multi-point back pressure test on the above captioned well for the purpose of working the well over to shut off the water production.

The work over job on this well, consisting of several cement squeeze jobs, was done during the latter part of December, 1971 and the first part of January, 1972.

After acidizing the well was produced at the rate of 500 MCF per day with a tubing pressure of 1375# on an 8/64" choke. Water production was 72 bbls per day. The rate was gradually increased to 1,500 MCF per day on a 19/64" choke, tubing pressure was 1025# and water production was 300 bbls per day. We cut the rate back to 500 MCF per day on a 9/64" choke for several days the tubing pressure gradually decreased from 1330# to 1165#. The last water gauge on 1-23-72 showed water production to be 142 bbls per day.

A multi-point back pressure test could not be run on the well in its present condition and we hereby request an extension of time for the test for the purpose of additional production tests and possibly another work over.
