Core #1 (8494-8534') -

Rec 40' limestone w/some porosity & fractures  
Cut & recovered 40' being limestone, cross-bedded fine to coarse crystalline, oolitic, pelletoid  
Porous - Good odor of gas - No bleeding  
Slightly Glauconitic - Brilliant blue florescence (8501-16 & 8520-32)  
Few crunoid fragments

Core #2 (8534-8573')

Rec 39' Limestone  
Limestone - dark brown to brown  
Very fine crystalline to sublighographic, slightly shaley w/scatter fossils of crinoid stem brachiopods  
Scattered chert - brown to dark brown
