This plan is submitted with Form 9-331C, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location, the construction activities and operations plan, the surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the drilling of this well.

1. EXISTING ROADS.

Exhibit A is a portion of a county map showing the roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed wellsite is located approximately 31 miles NNE of Roswell, New Mexico and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

DIRECTIONS.

- 1. Proceed north of Roswell of Highway 285 for a distance of 31 miles.
- 2. Turn east and go approximately 7.5 miles. At the fork in the road turn southeast.
- 3. Travel southeast approximately 1.4 miles or until a green tank appears on the left horizon.
- 4. Turn north here. Go past the green tank and continue to Mesa's, Jess Fed. #1 location, approximately 1 mile.
- 5. The road will be north from the Jess location on an existing ranch road approximately .4 of a mile. This road will be up graded.
- 6. The new road will start here.
- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD.
 - A. The proposed new access will be approximately .5 of a mile in length from point of origin to the southeast edge of the drilling pad. The road will lie in a northwest to southeast direction.
 - B. The new road will be 12 feet in width (driving surface).
 - C. The new road will be bladed with drainage on one side. No turnouts will be built.
 - D. The new route has been flagged and the route of the road is visible.
- 3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELL.
 - A. There are existing wells within a mile of the wellsite. See Exhibit A.
