

Plug #1: 50 sacks Class "C" Neat plug from 3750-3650'. PD 8:30 PM 6-7-82
Plug #2: 50 sacks Class "C" Neat plug from 1750-1650'. PD 9:20 PM 6-7-82

Ran 26 joints of 4-1/2" 10.5# J-55 casing at 1600'. 1-regular guide shoe at 1600'. Float collar at 1558'. Used 250 gallons of mud flush ahead of cement. Cemented w/ 300 sacks 50/50 Poz with 6# salt. Compressive strength of cement - 1050 psi in 12 hours. PD 2:10 PM 6-8-82. Bumped plug to 1000 psi, released pressure and float held okay. Cement circulated 25 sacks to pit. WOC. WIH and perforated 1397-1407' w/11 .50" holes. Spot acid across perforations 1397-1407' w/500 gallons 7 1/2% NE acid and 10 balls.
