Gentlemen:

Application is hereby made by Enserch Exploration, Inc. for administrative approval of a non-standard gas unit containing 308.46 acres for the J. G. O'Brien No. 4 well (attachment). This application is necessitated by the Range change between R28E and R29E, T7S, Chaves County, New Mexico.

This well was originally drilled as a Fusselman development well in the South Elkins Fusselman Oil Pool. However, upon completion this zone proved "wet" and the O'Brien No. 4 was recompleted in Pennsylvanian formation as a gas well. This recompletion has required Enserch to dedicate the W/2 of Section 31, T7S, R29E to the subject well which contains 308.46 acres, rather than 320 acres.

In addition, common ownership exists throughout Section 31.


