STANDARD STIPULATIONS FOR PIPELINE AND UNDERGROUND CABLE
RIGHTS-OF-WAY IN THE ROSWELL DISTRICT, BLM

(Pipeline)

Grantee agrees to comply with the following stipulations to the satisfaction of the BLM's Roswell District Manager:

1. Clearing and blading necessary for construction will be held to the absolute minimum. Without prior agreement, these actions will not exceed those limits agreed upon at the pre-construction inspection. Vegetation removed will be "walked-down" in place. *Not Applicable, See special stipulation B.*
2. Care will be taken by the grantee to assure that scenic values are not damaged in the disposal of waste materials. Any large rocks which are left as a result of construction activities will be placed so that they do not detract from the scenic view and do not hinder the movement of livestock or of big game animals. These residual rocks will not be piled or left in rows.
3. Roads will not be constructed where terrain features permit vehicles to maneuver without the aid of such construction. All vehicular traffic and construction activity will be confined to the authorized right-of-way.
4. Grantee will post the BLM serial number assigned to this right-of-way in a conspicuous place where this right-of-way intersects existing roads or highways. Along rights-of-way paralleling roads, BLM serial numbers will be posted where the right-of-way first crosses the public lands and where it finally leaves the public lands, unless otherwise agreed upon. *Not Applicable*
5. If a natural barrier which is being used for livestock control, is broken during construction, the grantee will adequately fence the area to prevent drift of livestock. Such fencing will be at his own expense.
6. To prevent slacking of fence wire, the grantee will brace and tie-off each existing fence to be crossed, before cutting. During construction, the opening will be protected to prevent the escape of livestock. Fences which have been cut during construction will be restored by the grantee to a condition which is equal to, or better, than the original. Cattleguards and adjacent gates which are of a suitable width will also be installed in any fence where a road created during construction is to be regularly traveled.
7. Gates or cattleguards on public lands will not be locked or closed to public use by the grantee.
8. Compatible with construction requirements, the period of time that trenches and other excavations are kept open by the grantee, will be held to a minimum.
9. Grantee ~~will~~ *(will not)* reseed. If reseeding is required, it will be done according to the following requirements for BLM's Roswell District: *See special stipulation B.*

10. All above-ground structures which are not subject to safety requirements, will be painted by the grantee to blend with the natural landscape. The paint used will be a color which simulates Federal Standard No. 595A:

11. In those areas where erosion control structures are required to stabilize soil conditions, the grantee will install such structures as are suitable for the specific soil conditions being encountered and which are in accordance with sound resource management practices.

12. Upon cancellation, relinquishment, or expiration of this right-of-way, the grantee will comply with those abandonment procedures as prescribed by BLM's Roswell District Manager.

13. The grantee will make a diligent effort to contact the BLM grazing permittee or lessee prior to entering the public lands on all grazing allotments.

14. Special stipulations:

A. At least one working day prior to commencing construction, the grantee will notify the authorized BLM officer.

B. No blading or clearing will be allowed on this project. If this stipulation is not followed, reseeding and any rehabilitation measures deemed necessary will be undertaken immediately by the grantee upon the request of the authorized BLM officer.

C. Total disturbance will not exceed 15 feet in width.

D. Two traffic barriers will be constructed. One will be located where the pipeline leaves Rose Federal #2 pad. The other will be located where the pipeline enters Rose Federal #1 pad area. The barriers will consist of 5 non-painted $6\frac{1}{2}$ foot wood fence posts spaced 4 feet apart across the pipeline disturbance. The posts will be buried 3 feet deep and extend $3\frac{1}{2}$ feet above the surface.

E. A sign stating "No Thoroughfare" and "Danger, Natural Gas Pipeline" will be attached to the center post of each barrier. In addition the company's name and phone number should be printed on the signs.

F. The pipeline will be buried to a minimum depth of 12 inches.

F. The pipeline will be buried to a minimum depth of 18 inches.
