We plan to install a new 2 7/8" pipeline from this well to the location of Vance Federal "A" No. 1, 2640' east. The pipeline will be wrapped and coated and buried in a ditch a minimum of 12" deep cut by a blade at an angle for minimum surface disturbance. The right-of-way is on Fee Surface. The surface owner, Bob Marley, has been contacted and an agreement has been made as to the damages and restoration of the surface. The proposed right-of-way is indicated in the archeological report enclosed. Transwestern Pipeline Company will be the new gas purchaser.

**1. ABSTRACT:** intensive archaeological survey of the Depco, Inc. Pipeline R/W for the Vance Fed. A Well No. 2 (2250 ft. long x 50 ft. wide). A total **fee land surface** of **2.58 acres** was inspected for cultural remains.

Archaeological survey did **not** reveal any cultural resources.

Therefore, archaeological **CLEARANCE** for the DEPCO, INC. pipeline R/W for the Vance Fed. A Well No. 2, on **fee lands**, is **RECOMMENDED**.

**2. PIPELINE R/W LOCATION:** T7S, R26E, Section 34, SE/4SW/4NW/4; SW/4SE/4NW/4; SE/4SE/4NW/4; SW/4SW/4NE/4. Chaves County, New Mexico.

**LAND STATUS:** Fee land surface, federal minerals.

**3. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Pipeline R/W for the Vance Fed. A Well No. 2 (2250 ft. long x 50 ft. wide). A total **fee land surface** of **2.58 acres** was inspected for cultural remains.

**TOPOGRAPHY:** the proposed Pipeline R/W for the Vance Fed. A Well No. 2 is in an area classified as Hollomex-Reeves-Milner, consisting of dry loams, in areas with 0 to 3% slopes. The soils are formed in calcareous, gypsiferous alluvium, and are deep and well drained. Hollomex loam occurs on ridges and knolls; Reeves loam is in depressional areas, with Milner soils intermingled in depressions. The pipeline R/W is between 3759 ft. and 3767 ft. in elevation, on a westward projecting ridge ca. 4550 ft. to 6050 ft. north of, and within the drainage of Eightmile Draw. The Pecos River is ca. 8700 to 9500 ft. west pipeline R/W. The local terrain is relatively level, with minor caliche and exposures of gypsiferous soils.

**VEGETATION:** grasses (grama, buffalo grass, 3-awn, muhly), snake-weed, mesquite, prickly pear, cholla, yucca, gyp coldenia, rare ephedra.

4. EXAMINATION PROCEDURE: parallel and zig-zag transects (spaced no further than 7 metres apart). Ca. 1.0 manhours on ground.

VISIBILITY: variable from 65% to 100%, with 100% in areas without vegetation; weather, sunny.

5. FINDINGS: BLM records (as of 4/14/87) do **not** indicate the prior recording of archaeological sites in Section 34 (T7S, R26E).

Archaeological survey of the DEPCO, INC. Pipeline R/W for the Vance Federal A Well No. 2 did **not** reveal any cultural resources.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS:

Since no cultural resources were found, archaeological **CLEARANCE** for the DEPCO, INC. Pipeline R/W for the Vance Fed. A Well No. 2, on fee land surface, is **RECOMMENDED**.

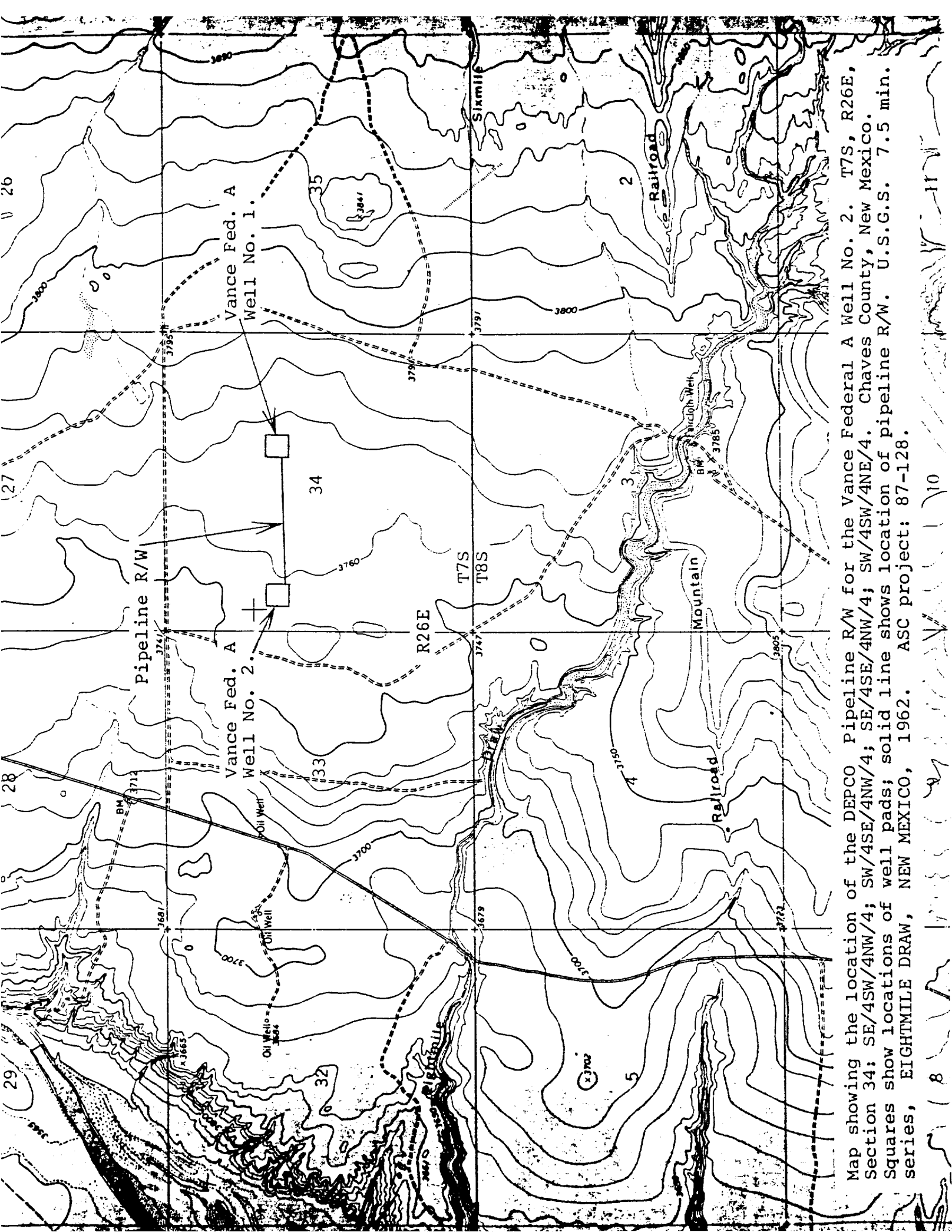
