Dear Mr. Williams:

Please let this letter and the enclosed mill certificates serve to warrant the 8 5/8" 24# J-55 Maverick casing Yates Petroleum ran in their Laura ZP#1 on August 23, 1989, to be API specification 5CT prime material. This product was produced on a conversion agreement with Paragon Industries out of Sapulpa, OK and warranted by Maverick Tube Corp.

I am sorry, but I cannot explain why the metal die stamp was inadvertently left off the tubes in question. There is no doubt in my mind this material is of API prime quality and therefore should have bore the API monogram not only in paint stencil but also the metal stamp.

Friday, August 25, a Maverick representative will survey the remaining material in Yates Petroleum's inventory and will die stamp all quantities not already bearing the API symbol along with the Maverick stamp.
