# APPLICATION OF PACIFIC ENTERPRISES OIL COMPANY FOR AN UNORTHODOX GAS WELL LOCATION, CHAVES COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

#### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

### **BY THE DIVISION:**

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on November 1, 1989, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Victor T. Lyon.

NOW, on this 20th day of November, 1989, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS THAT:

Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has (1) jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Pacific Enterprises Oil Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 2, Township 10 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, to test the Undesignated Foor Ranch-PrePermian Gas Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico.

Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 and the S/2 N/2 (N/2 equivalent) of said Section 2 is to (3) be dedicated to the well forming a 320.52-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

A well at the proposed unorthodox location will better enable the applicant (4) to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.

The evidence showed a fault to limit the productive area on the west side of (5) the tract such that only the east 60% is indicated to be productive.

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
