- 8. Ancillary Facilities:

- 9. Wellsite Layout:
 - A. Exhibit "A" shows the dimension of the well pad, reserve pits and prosed location of the tank battery.
- 10. Surface Restoration Plan:
 - A. After completion of drilling and/or completion operations all equipment and other materials not needed for operations will be removed. Pits will be filled and the location cleaned of all trash and junk to leave the wellsite in an aesthetically pleasing a condition as possible.
 - B. Any unguarded pits containing fluids will be fenced until they are filled.
 - C. If the proposed well is non-productive, all rehabilitation and/or vegetation requirements of the BLM will be accomplished as expeditiously as possible. All pits will be filled and leveled within 90 days after abandonment.
