02/03/01 - Spudded with rathole machine at 5:00 PM. Set 40' of 16" conductor pipe. Notified Stan Mayo of Roswell BLM of operations.

2/07/01 - Resumed drilling at 5:30 PM with rotary tools.

2/09/01 - TD of 14-3/4" hole at 918'.

2/10/01 - Ran 18 jts. (806.76') 11-3/4" 42# casing set at 808'. Texas Pattern guide shoe set at 808.76'.

Insert float set at 764.19'. Cemented with 400 sxs 35/65/6 C + 2% CaCl₂ + 1/8 PPS polyflake (yld 1.99, wt 12.6) Tailed in with 200 sxs C + 2% CaCl₂ (yld 1.32, wt 14.8). PD at 11:00 AM. Bumped plug to 800 psi, held OK. Circ 77 sxs. WOC.

Note: Casing became stuck at 808'. Had full returns and worked with pipe for 2 hours trying to free. Pipe was stuck hard without any play. Called Stan Mayo, who talked to David Glass and it was decided to cement pipe in place before it became parted. Stan instructed to go ahead and cement with the stipulation that if long string is set, Yates will run 1" to 900' between 11-3/4" and 5-1/2", bring cement 200' up into surface casing.

2/12/01 - Drilled out at 10:00 AM. WOC 47 hours. Reduced hole to 11" and resumed drilling.

2/19/01 - Drilling at 3944'. Lost 80% returns. Circulate and pump pills. Regained returns.

3/1/01 - Reached TD of 5574' at 4:15 AM. Log well. Logger's TD 5574'.
