Cemented with 510 sxs Pecos Valley Lite with 1 pps D44 + 4 pps D24 + .2% D65 + .3% D167 + .2% D46 + .1% D13 (yld 1.42, wt 13).

PD at 10:00 PM. Bumped plug to 1268 psi for 2 mins. Held OK.

After initial cement job, ran 1" to 1520' to top out. First stage, pumped 210 sxs 35:65 Poz with 6% D20 + 2% S1 + 1/8 pps D130.

Second stage, pumped 210 sxs AA. Circ 34 sxs to pit.

Notified Stan Mayo with Roswell BLM of operations.
