The painting requirement color has been changed to integrate the environmental color profile of the existing vegetation in this area. The holder shall adhere to the new color requirement for painting the structures and facilities of this well.

### Well Drilling Requirements;

#### H. Painting Requirement:

All above-ground structures not subject to safety requirements shall be painted by the holder to blend with the natural color of the landscape. The paint used shall be a color which simulates "Standard Environmental Colors" designated by the Rocky Mountain Five-State Interagency Committee. The color selected for this project is Juniper Green, (No Munsell Soil Color).
