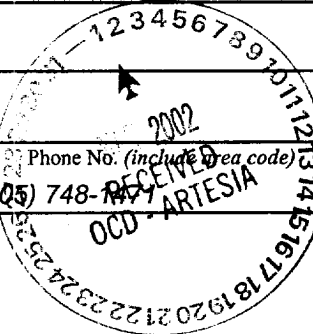

On 11-27-01, Yates turned in a Sundry Notice on the re-route road. During a Cultural Survey, an arch site was found and the road was re-routed to avoid the site. Yates requests that this second re-route be accepted and made part of the Application for Permit to Drill.

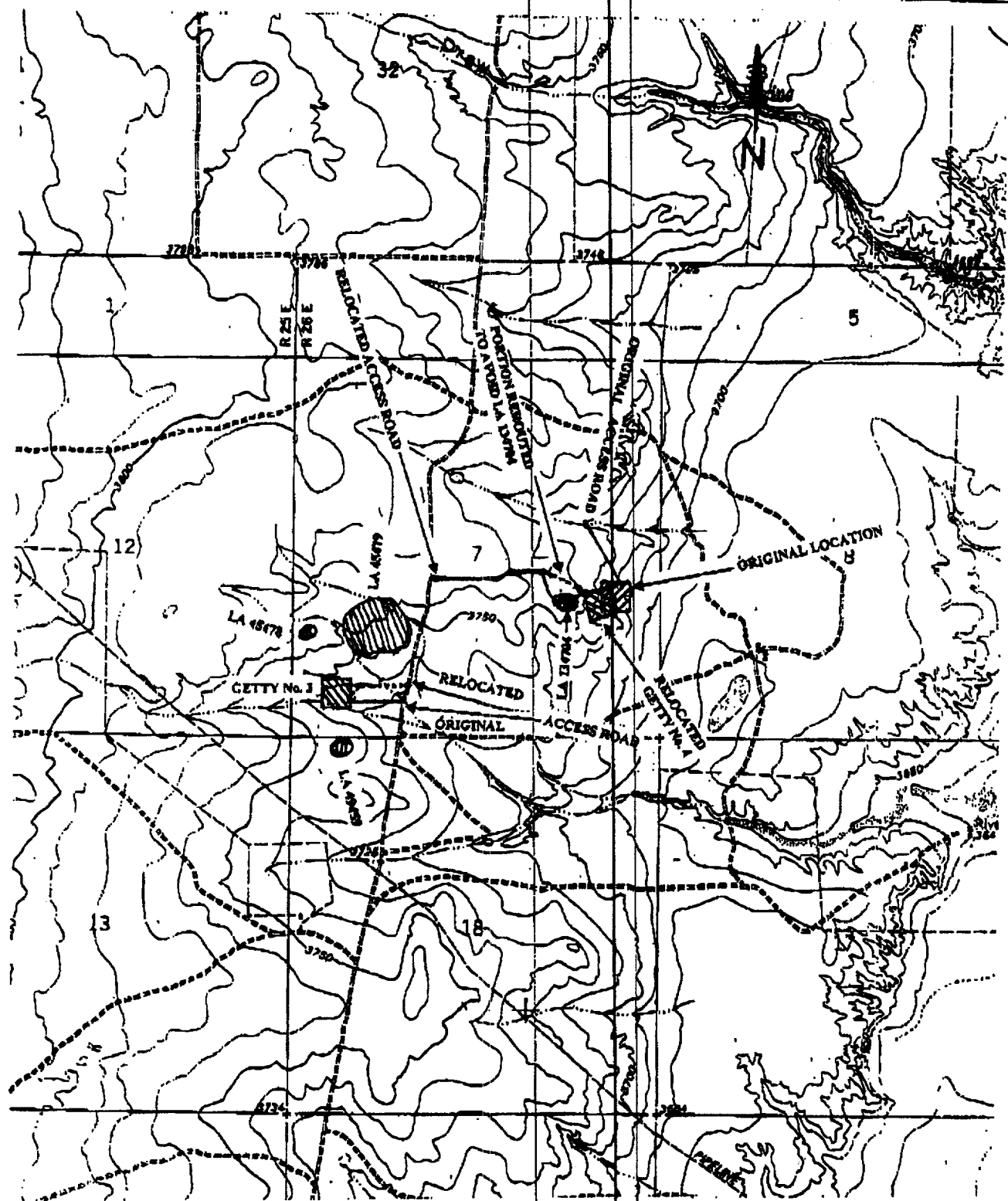

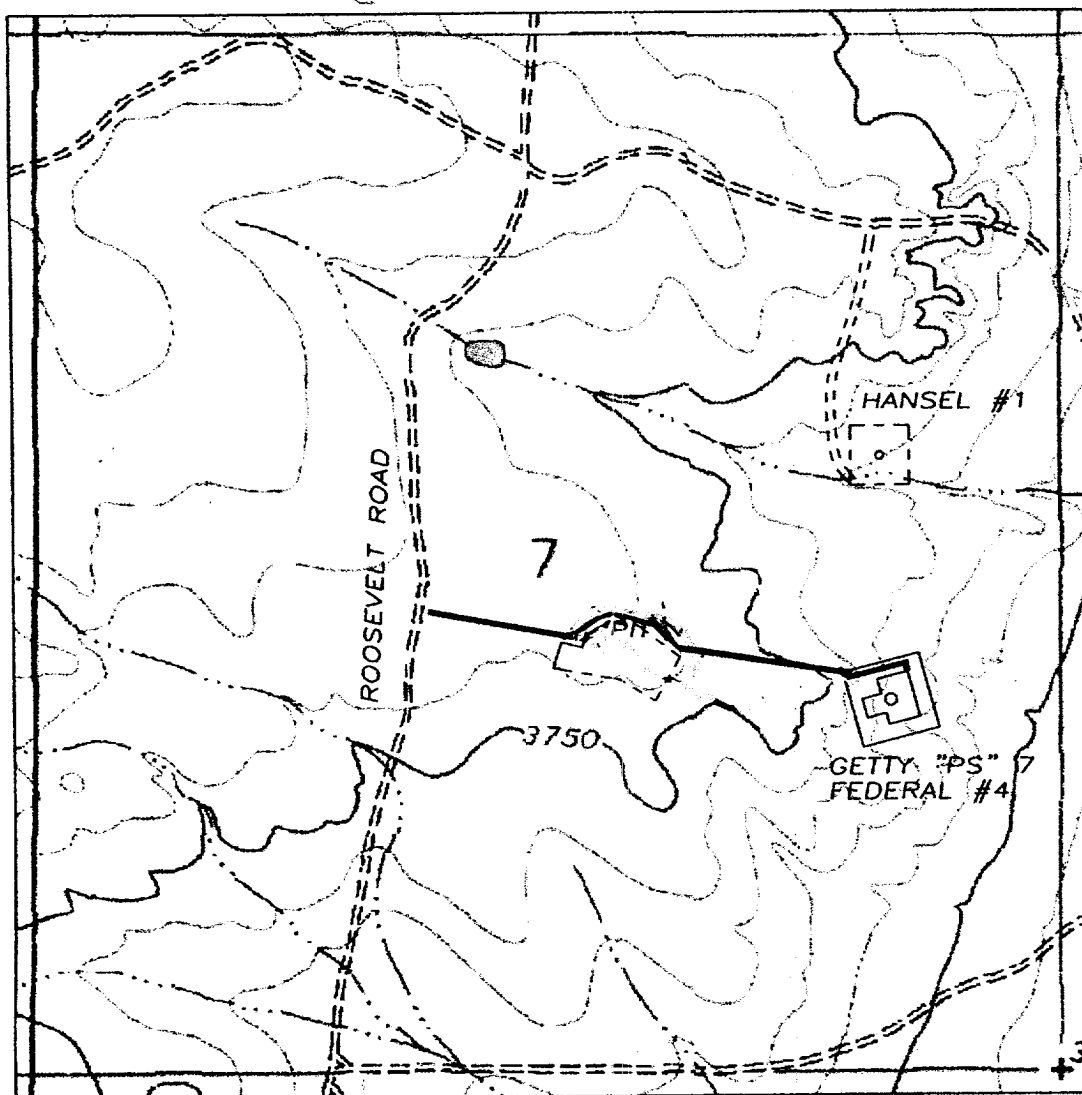
