- 2. Yates Petroleum Corporation requests that a variance be granted in requiring the casing and BOPE to be tested to 2000 PSI to testing the casing and BOPE to 1000 PSI. The rig pumps will be used to test the casing and BOPE. Rig pumps used in this area cannot safely test above 1000 PSI. We would have to go to the greater expense of hiring an independent service to do the testing. Also, the bottom hole pressure in this field is proven to be near 1000 PSI. This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the above described well. The purpose of this plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of the surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operations, so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effect associated with the operations.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

Exhibit A is a portion of the BLM map showing the well and roads in the vicinity of the proposed location. The proposed well site is located approximately 42 miles northeast of Roswell, New Mexico and the access route to the location is indicated in red and green on Exhibit A.

DIRECTIONS:

Go north of Roswell, NM on 285 approx. 25 miles from the intersection of 70 & 285 to Dona Anna Road. Turn east on Dona Anna and go approx. 10.6 miles. The new road will start here and go SE for approx. 0.2 of a mile to the SW corner of the pad.

PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. The proposed new access will be approximately 1300' in length from the point of origin to the southeast corner of the pad. The road will lie in a southeasterly direction.
- B. The new road will be 14 feet in width (driving surface) and will be adequately drained to control runoff and soil erosion.
- C. Existing roads will be maintained in the same or better condition as they are now.

- 8. ANCILLARY FACILITIES: This APD is being used to apply for the on lease flow line from this well to the tie-in point on the Everette "OO" Fed. #3 location in the NENE of Section 26-T5S-R24E. A map of the proposed pipeline is included as Exhibit "E".

9. WELLSITE LAYOUT:

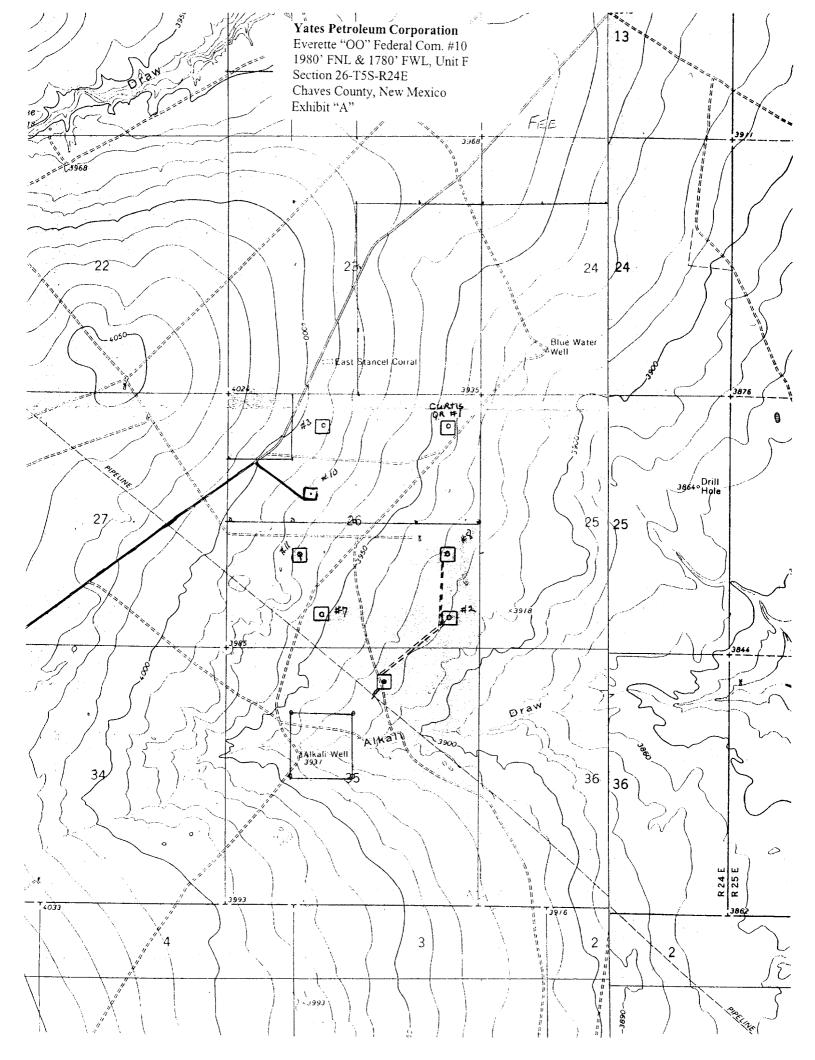

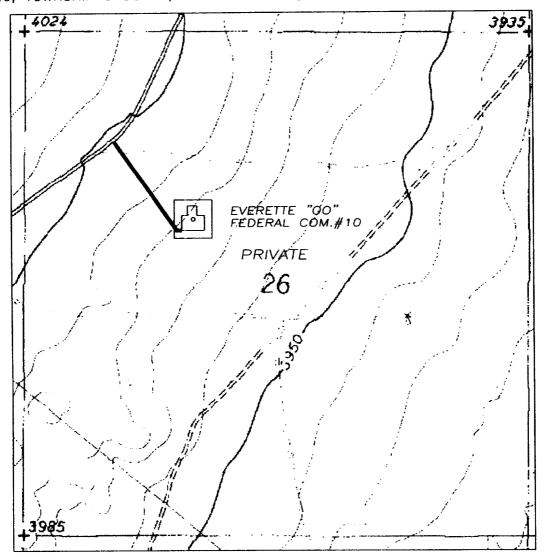

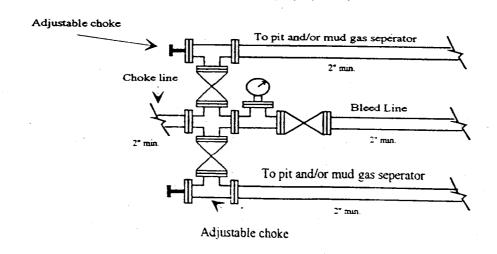
Typical 2,000 psi Pressure System Schematic

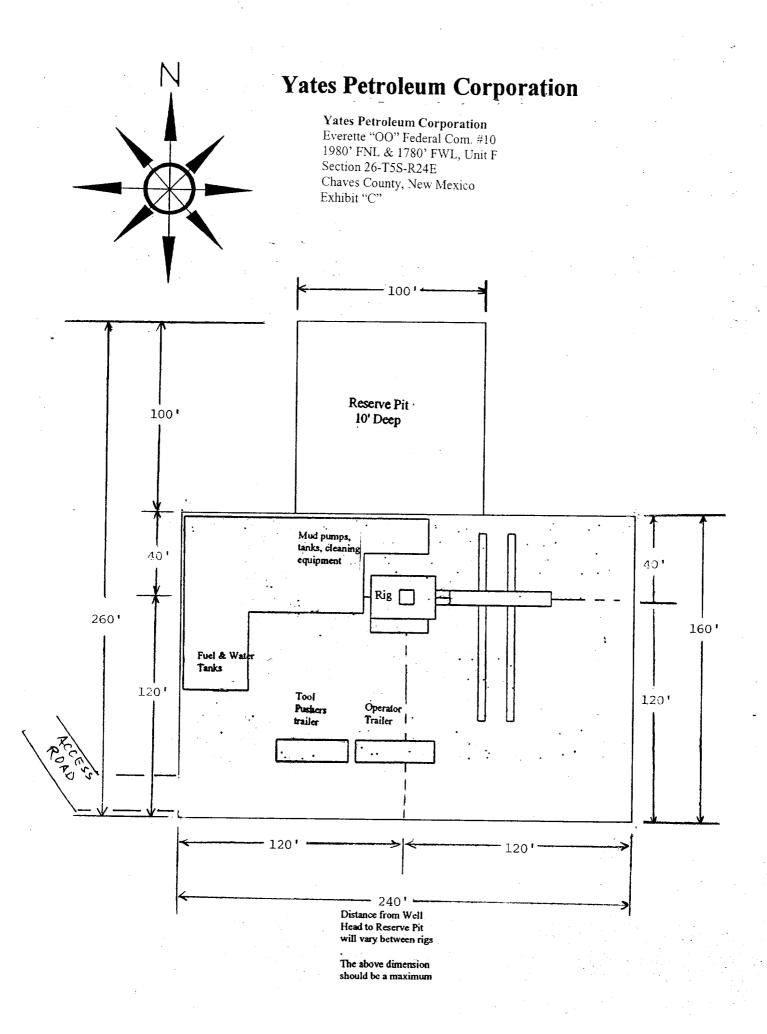

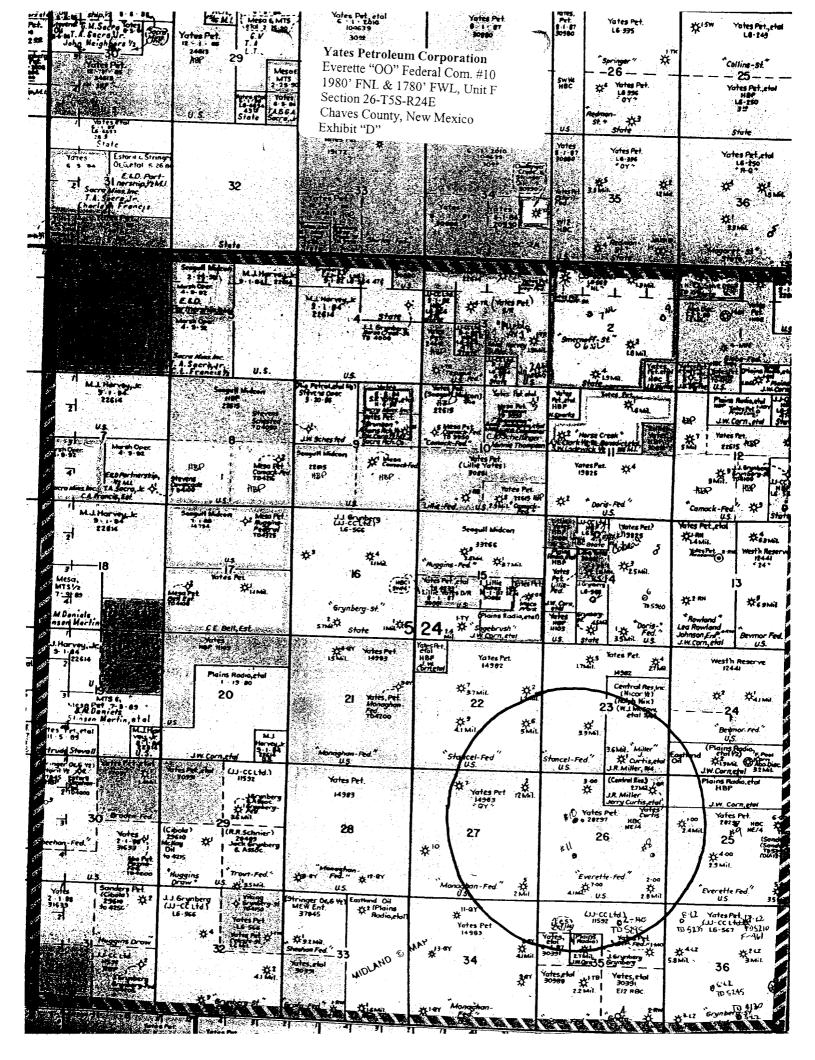
