On Nov. 18 drilled out the cement and then we put 250 gallons acidize, we swab the well and Nov. 19 we put 250 gallons of acid and swab no result we only got the acid back.

Nov 20, 1968 I called Mr. Sutherland in Roswell New Mexico for the plugging of the well, He said to put a 100 feet of cement in the bottom of hole and a 100 feet at top with marker we put 150 feet of cement bottom and filled hole with drilling mud between plugs and 120 feet at top of hole.

I sent this report to Roswell with Dowell work sheet showing how the work was done, we left all casing in the hole, had to leave down this before the cleaning and leveling was done I left because of a death, the man said he would it all.
