Mr. W. A. Gressett, Supervisor and Oil and Gas Inspector of District II, Artesia, New Mexico, 88210, called me about the Charles M. Goad, State I, 660 S, 660 W, Sec. 28, T-2-S, R-26-E, south of Ft. Sumner, which you plan to plug for your client.


We will have to establish total depth of the well by running a wire line measurement. After establishing the TD, we will pump a 50 sack plug from 950-1100, providing the well is not deeper than 1300 ft. Set a 35 sack plug from 150-250 ft. and a surface plug of 15 sacks with proper marker and clean location.

You may want someone in Ft. Sumner to do this work, mainly because of the price we would have to charge. If you do get someone in Ft. Sumner, I would be glad to say whether or not they are giving you a fair price to plug the well. Hobbs is approximately 190 miles from Ft. Sumner.

Possibly a water well contractor in Ft. Sumner could help you.

Please advise if we can be of any more assistance.
