FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Hobson #1 was drilled to a total depth of 6742' in granite. Four drill stem tests were taken and an electric log was run by Schlumberger. No evidence of commercial production was indicated on any of these tests.

It is proposed to load the hole with mud laden fluid, spot 50 sacks cement at 6500' to 6338'; spot 25 sacks 4000' to 3919'; 25 sacks 2296 to 2215' and 30' plug in top of hole. A 4" pipe marker is to mark the abandoned location.
