I am now ready to plug the well or leave it as a water well, the rancher Mr. Overton would like to have this for a water well, but want be reliable for any cost, it has a lot of water at 763 feet, we have casing set and cemented with 75 sacks of sement at 545 feet 103/4 casing, the top of the casing is covered by welding a cover on it.

The ground around it has been leved up and the pits has been filled and leveled.

Conserning leaving it as a water well I agree to leave all casing in hole and fix the top how ever you want it, If this is satisfactory let me know what you require of me to do.

If you want it plugged I will do so immediately.
