Commenced drilling 17½" hole 9 AM 9-26-85. Drilled to total depth 961'. Ran 13 3/8" casing on 10-6-85 with multistage collar at 499'. Cemented with Dowell-Schlumberger with 1st stage of 100 sacks Lightweight III + 5#/sk Kolite + ¼#/sk cellophane Flake + 3% Calcium Chloride. Plug down 11 AM 10-6-85 Pressured to 2000#, opened multistage collar- pumped 2nd stage cement 200 sacks RFC + 400 sacks Lightweight III + 3% Calcium Chloride + ¼#/sk cellophane flakes + 5#/sk Kolite + 100 sacks Lightweight III + 3% Calcium Chloride. Plug down 4:30 PM 10-6-85. Tested casing to 2000# cement circulated to surface. Tested Hydril to 600#. Drill out multistage collar and test casing and Hydril to 1000# for 30 minutes. No Leak during test 2AM 10-8-85. 13 3/8" 61#, 68# & 72# N-80 & K-55 ST&C Casing.
