Dear Sir:

This office has received no report covering the subject well since Commission Form C-103 dated June 18, 1970. Said report was approved on July 1, 1970, with the provision that drilling operations must be resumed within sixty (60) days or the well must be properly plugged and abandoned. One hundred and twenty days (120) have now elapsed and with no indication that drilling activity has resumed. Therefore we are now calling upon you to immediately resume the drilling of this well or commence the plugging of the same. This office must be contacted prior to initiation of either of these operations.

Failure to comply with the above within twenty (20) days, will result in my requesting that the Commission docket a hearing to allow all interested parties to appear and show cause why the well should not be properly plugged and abandoned.
