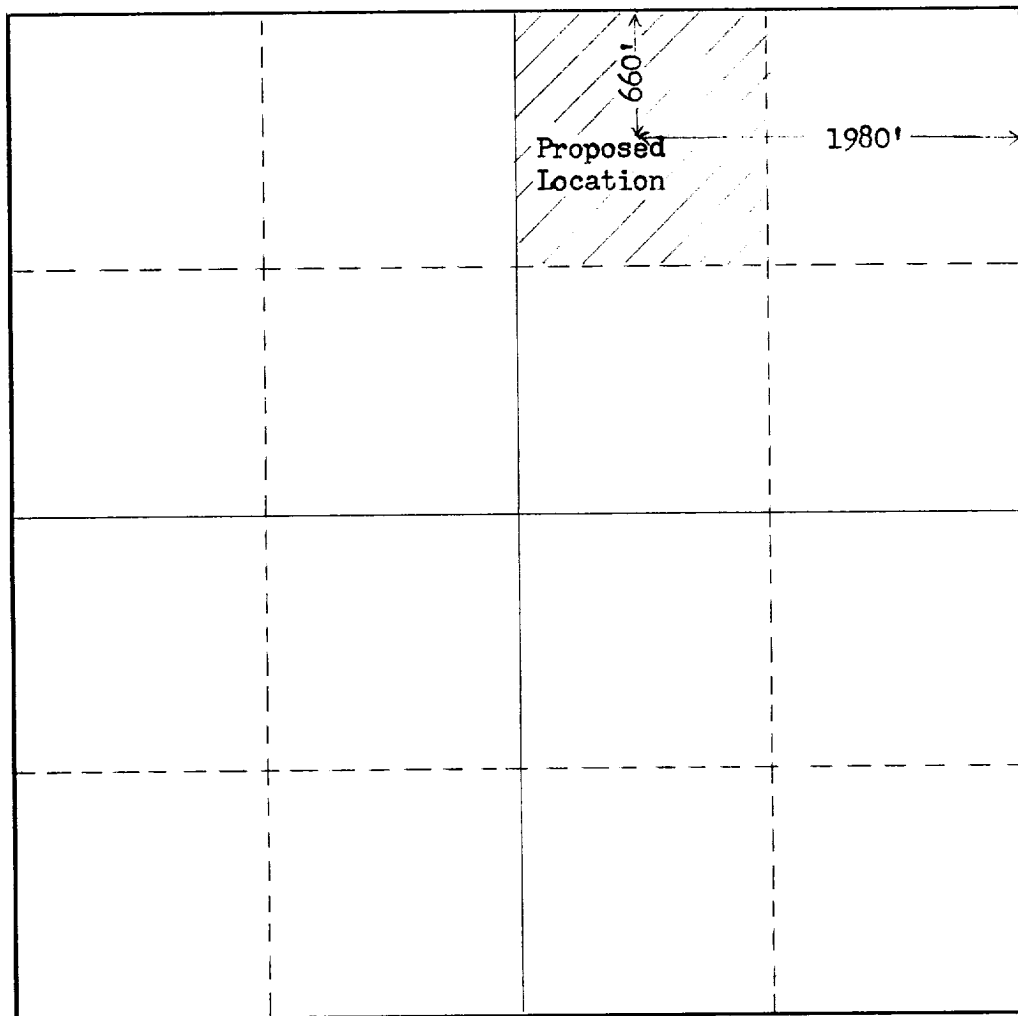


Gentlemen:

Enclosed is the original and five copies of Application for Permit to Drill together with the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat, for the Cockrell Corporation State Lease L 1197 (14) No. 1 Well, Hidalgo County, New Mexico.

We propose to drill this well with a rotary rig using a water base mud drilling fluid. It is anticipated that approximately 2,500 feet of 13-3/8-inch surface casing, cemented to the surface, will adequately protect fresh water sands and insure being able to control any pressures that may be encountered below that depth. If additional casing strings are required for shutting off lost returns or for making a completion you will be advised.
