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

Dear Mr. Schaber:

Reference is made to your letter of April 5th pertaining to the drilling of a wildcat exploratory well in Hidalgo County, New Mexico described as Section 12, Township 30 South, Range 15 West.

Our geologists recommend that the unorthodox location of your projected well is in order because of irregularities in topography at the normal spacing point, aside from the geologic factors mentioned in your letter. Therefore, by the authority granted me in Rule 104, Section 'f', of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, I am approving the unorthodox location as proposed: 628 feet from the east line and 335 feet from the south line of the 40 acre tract described as NE/4 SW/4 Section 12, Township 30 South, Range 15 West, NMPM, Hidalgo County.
