We have your letter of October 19, 1954, stating that Basabe and Rupe Drilling Company has been adjudged bankrupt and asking that the surety company be released from its obligation if conditions of the bond have been satisfactorily fulfilled.

According to our records, this well has never been plugged. We have had several requests from the Ft. Worth office of Houston Fire and Casualty in this same problem, but when the Commission's oil and gas inspector at Artesia, N. M., made his last field check late in August 1954, he reported that the well was still unplugged. There have been rumors that Mr. Carl Ryberg, the landowner, planned to take over this well (Ryberg No. 1, SW NE 24-28-14E) and drill it deeper, but we have no official notification of this, nor has Mr. Ryberg furnished bond.

In the meantime, the captioned bond must remain in effect. If we can help you further, please let us know.
